The IEEE (Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers) Power Electronics Society will host a workshop for the participants of the 2007 International Future Energy Challenge during the 2007 IEEE Applied Power Electronics Conference (APEC'07) in Anaheim, California, USA (<http://www.apec-conf.org/>). This workshop will be held at the conference site of APEC'07: Disneyland® Hotel, 1150 Magic Way, Anaheim, California 92802, USA.

The workshop will be held on Sunday, February 25, 2007. The workshop will focus on the 2007 event, including an overview of the specifications and testing that will be performed, technical concerns of participants, and safety. There will also be guest speakers from industry to discuss the latest innovations in power electronics and motor drives. Please note that there will be no advance payments. There are several guidelines regarding this funding. It may not be used for faculty travel. Only those students working toward their first degree are eligible. The recipient must make a presentation at the workshop describing the efforts and deliverables described in the proposal.
